

SETUP YOUR GOOGLE E-MAIL ADDRESS TO BE USED BY PESAMAIL

Google has added security layers on Gmail such that third party applications not done by google don't integrate easily to GMAIL.

This includes Outlook, Wordpress etc.


- The Mail app on your iPhone or iPad with iOS 6 or below
- The Mail app on your Windows phone preceding the 8.1 release
- Some Desktop mail clients like Microsoft Outlook and Mozilla Thunderbird

1. Logon to your Gmail email address

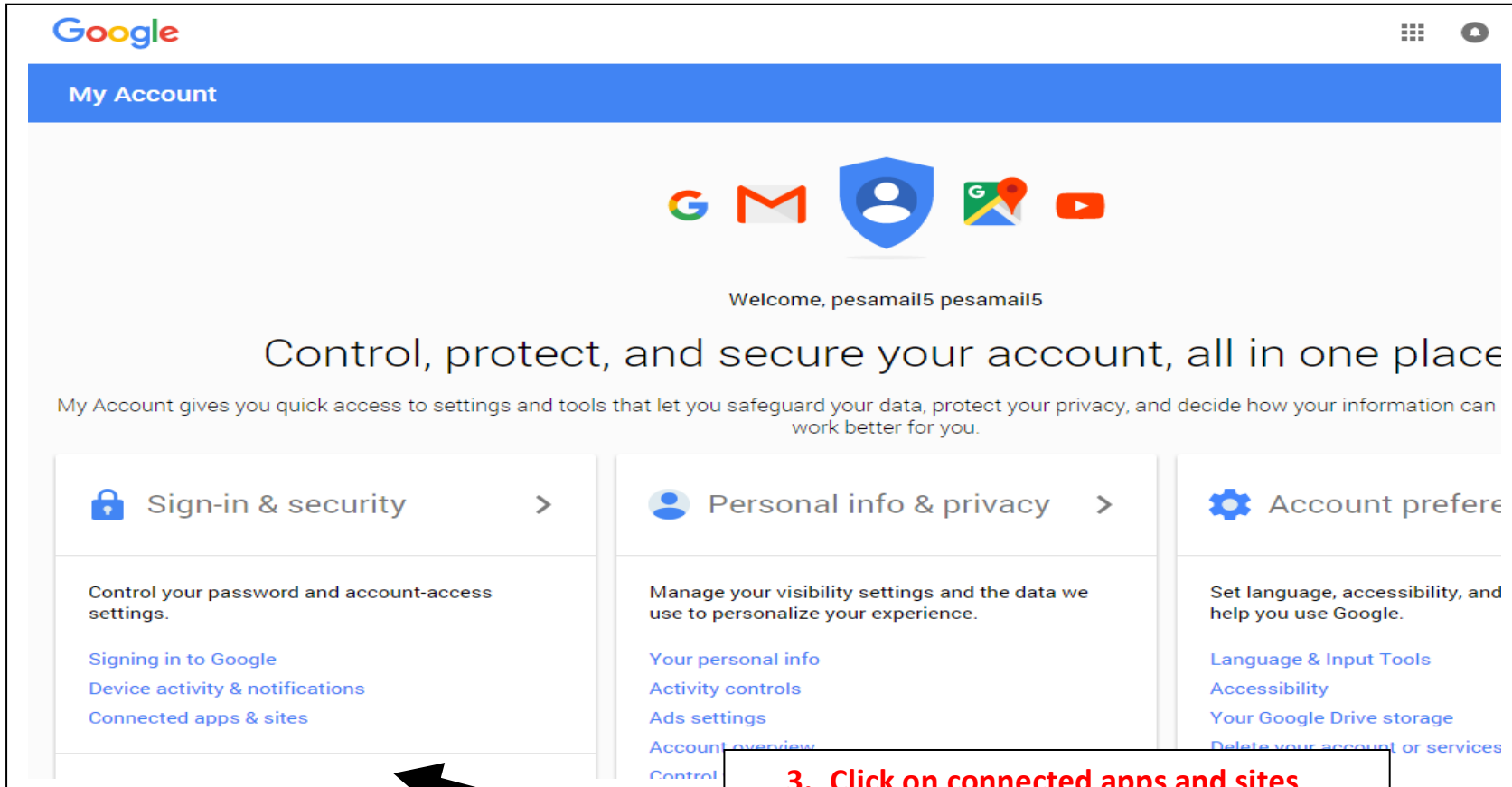
